I am aware of the overall implementation plan for our school. I know which implementation tasks I'm responsible for and how to carry them out. I have access to all the equipment I need to implement the program.

#### PARTIAL IMPLEMENTATION

60% or more teachers report the following:



have or know how to the get the materials I need to teach and/or reinforce skills and concepts.

I have adequate implementation support.

I feel confident in my ability to reinforce lesson concepts and skills.

I reinforce the lesson skills and concepts.

I know where and how to get resources to help improve my practice.

I feel adequately trained to deliver the lessons.

I understand how I can help monitor the implementation process.

I send Home Links to my students' families.

I believe my students are benefitting from the Second Step program.

Less than 60% of teachers report the following:



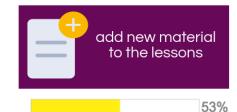
I have adequate time to prepare for lesson delivery. I do the Daily Practice activities with my students. I use the program's formative and summative assessments to monitor student progress.
